Dear Mom and Dad.

It has been four months since I left home in Houston. I have had a good time here in Kamakura. I have made a lot of friends at school. Today I am writing to you about a wonderful experience during the winter vacation.

On the late afternoon of December 31, my host family took me to Hayama Beach in the west of the Miura Peninsula. (I never expected to go to a beach on a cold winter day.) We arrived at Hayama Beach at 4:30 p.m. and took a walk around the beach. After a while, we watched a sunset, the last sunset of the year. As we watched, the sun set behind Mt. Fuji. Mt. Fuji looked like a sparkling diamond. It was so beautiful.

After we got back to Kamakura, we went to eat *soba* (buckwheat noodles) at Issa-an, a famous *te-uchi* (handmade) *soba* restaurant. This was the first time I have had handmade buckwheat noodles. *Te-uchi soba* was one of the best dishes I have ever had in Japan.

On New Year's Day, my host family woke me up at 4:30 a.m. and took me to Miura Beach in the east of the Miura Peninsula. It was early in the morning, but Miura Beach was full of people. A number of people were visiting the beach to watch *Hatsuhinode* (the first sunrise of the year). They also came to enjoy a *Hatsuhinode* event: *furumai* (free soup), *taiko* (drum) performances, and *mikan* (mandarin) throwing. This annual event was held by the city of Miura.

When *furumai* started at 5:30 a.m., we waited in line and got soup for free. Free soup was made from local fish and vegetables. It tasted good. Two *taiko* performances were given—the first at 6:00 a.m. and the second at 6:50 a.m. — to welcome the sunrise. When a group of Japanese drummers were performing at

6:50 a.m., the sun rose above the horizon. As we watched the sunrise, we enjoyed the drums performance like a religious ceremony. When *mikan* throwing began at 7:00 a.m., a lot of mandarins were thrown to give people a chance to try their New Year's luck. Luckily I got two.

I had a wonderful experience during the winter vacation. The new school term begins tomorrow. I hope I will do well at school in the Year of the Pig.
